- The occasional felling of trees for local uses on the same property or by the same landowner or manager
- Small plantations and woodlots of *five hectares or less*
- Plantings established for non-commercial purposes
- Revegetation operations conducted for the purposes of erosion or salinity control

- Harvesting of private native forests (removal/destruction of native vegetation (Cl 52.17)
- Local planning objectives -area of operation is within a land use management overlay eg wildfire, erosion
- Proposed area for new plantation establishment is > 40 ha (Cl 52.18-3)
- Others?
