ABOUT REGISTRATION

Under the provisions of the 'Domestic Animals Act 1994', all dogs and cats must be registered by 10 April each year, or when they reach three months of age - whichever comes first. Owners who do not comply may face a fine of two penalty units - currently \$395.

Your animal must wear its registration tag at all times. If your animal is lost or injured, the tag can help us quickly advise you of your animal's location and condition, and how to collect it. It is the responsibility of owners to ensure animals are secured within their property. Animals found wandering may be caught and impounded, and owners may need to pay a release fee and infringement penalties. If the animal is not registered, owners will also have to pay the registration fee before taking the animal home.

Each property in a residential area is limited to keeping no more than two dogs and two cats. Each property in a rural area is limited to keeping up to five dogs and five cats. A permit is required to keep any additional dogs or cats. Contact Council to apply for a permit.

- has an obedience certificate issued by an approved organisation #
- a hound registered with the Game Management Authority
